



H&S POLICY

Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974

It is the policy of Chalmor Limited to provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our work activities and to maintain an environment for all employees, visitors and the general public that is as healthy and safe as can be reasonably foreseen.

The company has the objective of the prevention of accidents and cases of work related ill health, the elimination of health hazards, the prevention of personal injury, minimising lost time through accidents, and the application of measures to promote occupational health by consulting with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety.

Within the design, manufacture, construction, operation and maintenance of all plant, products, equipment and facilities, it is the intention of Chalmor Limited to do everything reasonably practicable to provide and maintain safe plant and equipment and prevent personal injury and illness.

To this end Chalmor Limited will provide adequate training information, instruction and supervision to all employees as required, together with all necessary safety equipment, controls and personal protection equipment, to ensure all employees are competent to do their tasks and can safely handle and use substances.

It is equally the duty of every employee to exercise responsibility and to take reasonable care of their own health and safety and any other person who may be affected by their actions or omissions while at work. Each employee has a legal obligation to support the company in achieving its Health and Safety objectives contained within the company Health and Safety Policy.

Our Health and Safety Policy Statement will be reviewed and revised as necessary at regular intervals.
